Services provided by school-based infant programs are determined by the

Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) Process

The process includes intake, assessment and program planning based on family strengths and needs.

Children with the following disabilities may be eligible:

- Developmental delays
- Established risk for developmental delays

The initial referrals are made to the Tri-Counties or North Los Angeles County Regional Center. The schools serve all children with only these disabilities:

- Deafness/hard of hearing
- Visually impaired
- Severe orthopedic impairments

The schools provide all Early Start services for these children.

The Schools will "*dually serve*" children with Tri-Counties Regional Center according to the following priorities *up to* funded capacity:

- Children who need vision or hearing services
- Children with CA Children Services MTU eligible diagnoses
- Children with multiple handicaps especially cognitive impairments

The schools will provide special education and related services for these children. The Regional Center provides other Early Start services.
